

LAS ESCALAS MAYORES





Recorta tres cartoncitos de distintas formas y colócalos sobre el teclado tal como se indica en la figura I*. Después transporta siempre el inferior una octava hacia arriba (observa las figuras II*, III* y IV*), y toca el acorde obtenido. Haz lo mismo bajando, transportando el cartoncito superior una octava hacia abajo.

Observa que se trata siempre de los mismos tres tonos. La diferencia sólo consiste en el distinto orden de estos tonos.

Repite el juego empezando con otros tonos, como por ejemplo Sol-Si-Re, etc. Todos tienen la misma digitación como lo muestra el ejemplo siguiente:




